

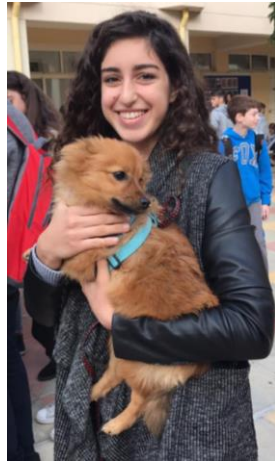


WhatsUp @ PESLarnaka?
