





SCHOOL PROFILE

PASCAL Primary Schools in the towns of Lefkosia, Larnaka and Lemesos, offer a safe, happy and friendly environment in which teachers and parents/guardians work in the spirit of collaboration. PASCAL Primary Schools aim to ensure that their pupils become responsible global citizens, engaged with issues of importance, such as environment and community. The main aim is for all children to enjoy learning from a balanced curriculum that will develop their talents and critical thinking skills.

The school curriculum is consistently enriched with real-life and concrete experiences which are creatively planned, vibrant and exciting. Children with little or no English are given additional support through intensive English language lessons with an aim of enabling them to access the curriculum as soon as possible.

Priority placement is offered at PASCAL Secondary Schools to PASCAL Primary School pupils who maintain an impeccable behavioural record, without the prerequisite of taking the entrance examinations.

KINDERGARTEN (PRE-RECEPTION AND RECEPTION)

- Pre-Reception Age: 3 years 4 years 9 months
- Reception Age: 4 years and 10 months 5 years and 7 months*

*As of 2020/21, Cyprus Ministry of Education and Culture guidelines mandate a change in the school enrolment age to 5 years for Reception.

CURRICULUM

The children in Kindergarten work towards early learning goals through a structured programme of rich learning experiences, developing the skills, knowledge and understanding that prepares them for Primary Year 1.

There are seven areas of learning and development that shape the educational programmes in early years settings. All areas of learning and development are important and inter-connected and are particularly crucial for igniting children's curiosity and enthusiasm for learning, as well as for building their capacity to learn, form relationships and thrive.

The areas are:

- communication and language
- physical development
- personal, social and emotional development
- literacy
- mathematics
- understanding the world
- expressive arts and design

CURRICULUM

PASCAL Primary Schools follow Cambridge
Primary Curriculum for the three core subjects
of English, Mathematics and Science, which
combines a world-class curriculum with
integrated assessment. With respect to the
Greek language, the schools follow the Cyprus
Ministry of Education and Culture curriculum.
Regarding the foundation subjects, which
include Environmental Studies, Geography,
History, Art and Design, Music, Physical
Education, Design and Technology/Home
Economics, ICT and World Religions the schools
offer a combination of the British National
Curriculum with some revisions to reflect
Cypriot geographical and historical identity.











ASSESSMENT

The main aim of the schools' systematic assessment is to enable each pupil to identify areas for development and to chart progress. This also helps the school strengthen learning across the curriculum. The school issues a progress report twice a year for all years. Cambridge Primary Progression tests are incorporated into continuous assessment for all years.

EXTENDED DAY (HOMEWORK SUPPORT AND ACTIVITIES)

Extended Day Programme is provided on an optional basis after school. Albeit, attendance is recommended to all pupils, from Kindergarten to Year 6 as the purpose of Homework Support is to help pupils to develop their study skills, become independent learners and to give an additional opportunity for them to resolve any queries they may have about the material taught during the school day.

Activities after the homework support run throughout the academic year in order to give pupils the opportunity to develop their skills and talents outside the academia. Activities are designed to support the physical and social development for all years. Pupils are encouraged to undertake exciting, constructive, challenging and enjoyable activities.











HOME-SCHOOL LINKS

PASCAL Primary Schools place great importance on the relationship with parents/guardians believing that children learn best when families and school work together with unity of goals.

Therefore, pupils have a home/school daily planner where messages from home and school are noted and informative newsletters, emails and mobile telephone texts are sent out to parents on a regular basis to maintain close communication between all parties.

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR

PASCAL Primary Schools provide a caring environment where individuality is celebrated and everyone is respected. Through positive behaviour reinforcement and a systematic whole school approach, pupils feel positive and confident about themselves, their abilities, achievements and their power of decision making.

HEALTHY EATING

Nutritious hot lunches are provided on an optional basis for the children by the schools' EN ISO 22000 certified catering services. All schools encourage healthy food choices.

BUS SERVICE

A local bus company provides transportation to and from the schools.
