### **ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS 2023/2024**

- ***Information for English native speakers and speakers of other languages***
- ***Greek native speakers please refer to the circular in the Greek language***

The Entrance Examinations for prospective Year 1 pupils for PASCAL Private English School Lefkosia will take place on **Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2023** at the following times:

**English\*                    09:00–10:30**

**Mathematics            11:00–12:30**

**\* *English for Native Speakers or English for Speakers of Other Languages.***

The following topics are not included in the Mathematics examined syllabus:

- Circle
- Transformations
- Stereometry
- Volume

**Preparatory lessons** for the Entrance Examinations can be offered **every Wednesday from 15:00 until 17:10**. Prospective pupils who participate in these lessons will familiarise themselves with the syllabus and the structure of the Entrance Examinations.

Prospective pupils' parents/guardians can book **private informative sessions** with the Head of School by calling 22509000 or sending an email to [lefkosia.info@pascal.ac.cy](mailto:lefkosia.info@pascal.ac.cy) and/or they can attend the **school presentation, at the school premises, on 23<sup>rd</sup> of February from 17:30 until 18:15**.

Those interested in taking the examinations must register at the school office as follows:

<b>Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday</b>	<b>7:15–16:00</b>
<b>Wednesday</b>	<b>7:15–15:00</b>

On registration a **copy of the candidate's birth certificate** along with a **recent photo** must be submitted. The Entrance Examinations fee is €50. Registration can be made online. For details, visit <https://www.pascal.ac.cy/news/pascal-english-school/>

The candidate number is recorded on the receipt issued upon registration for the Entrance Examinations and it should be written on the examination papers below the name and surname. The personal password is also recorded on the receipt and it is to be used, together with the candidate number to access the results on the school website.

## **RESULTS OF EXAMINATIONS – SCHOOL REGISTRATION 2023/2024**

The Entrance Examinations results will be published on **Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022** on the school website. The personal password recorded on the receipt must be used, together with the candidate number, to access the results on the school website. The **registration will take place after the announcement of the Entrance Examinations results until Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup> April 2023.**

The registration per pupil consists of the following:

- € 400 Admission Fee
- € 40 Parents and Guardians Association annual subscription
- €2,260 Towards annual tuition fee
- €2,700 TOTAL

The above amounts are not refundable under any circumstances as they guarantee (represent a deposit) a pupil's attendance at school for at least one school year, and they are not an advance fee payment.

The school reserves the right to invite pupils for an interview as well as not to register a pupil regardless of the Entrance Examinations result.

PASCAL Private Primary School pupils are not required to take the Entrance Examinations but they might be invited for an interview. Those applying for a scholarship will be examined on PASCAL Private Primary School syllabus (Cambridge Primary). PASCAL Private Primary School pupils are considered to be continuing pupils therefore, they pay Registration Fee €300 instead of Admission Fee €400 (total payment on registration €2,600).

## **SCHOLARSHIPS**

Scholarships are awarded to the top candidates and/or after a formal interview (100% or 50% or 25% discount on tuition fees). Only pupils who take English for Native Speakers Entrance Examination are eligible for a scholarship.

The scholarship will apply for the entire duration of the pupil's academic study provided the pupil meets the requirements of the school's regulations each year as given in the Study Guide, Rules and Regulations. The scholarship will apply if a pupil achieves the minimum grade as determined by the Entrance Examinations regulations which are as follows:

- 100% scholarship – minimum grade (average) 95%
- 50% scholarship – minimum grade (average) 90%
- 25% scholarship – minimum grade (average) 85%

## **ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS AFTER THE 11<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2023**

Pupils who, for whatever reason, do not take the examinations on the 11<sup>th</sup> March 2023 will have the chance to take the Entrance Examinations on Tuesday, 14<sup>th</sup> March 2023, from 15:00 until 18:30. The Entrance Examination fee for this sitting is €100 and pupils are not eligible for the above scholarships as the scholarships will have been awarded by then.
